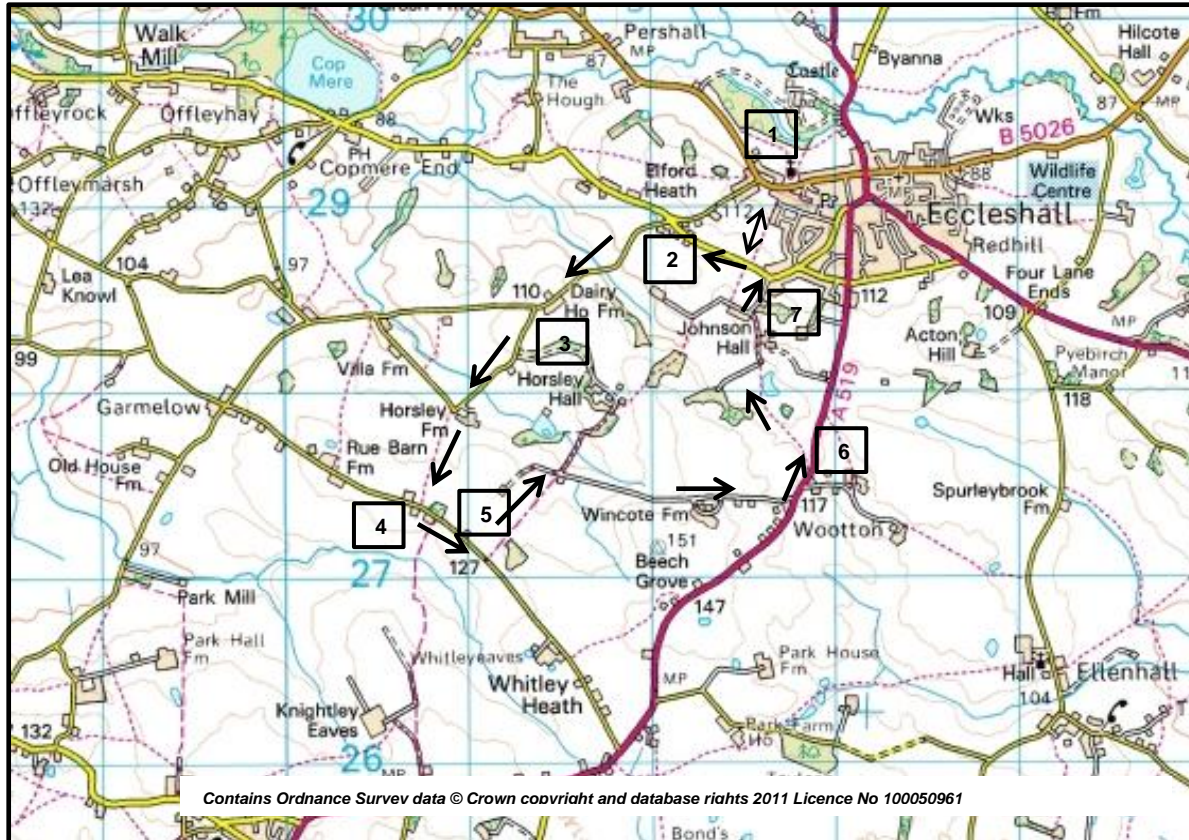

WALK NO 11 - ECCLESHALL –
ELFORD, HORSLEY, CASH LANE, WINCOTE -
ECCLESHALL

This walk starts at 'The Washpits', opposite Holy Trinity Church, High Street, Eccleshall. It is approximately 4 miles long.

Leave the Washpits and walk south, through a metal kissing gate. Continue uphill, past the house gardens on a track with hedges and fences on both sides. Eventually there will be a chain linked fence on your left and you will come to a kissing gate and barrier.

(1) At the road TAKE CARE, turn right onto Shaws Lane and walk for 500 metres past the allotments and a few houses to a small cross roads.

(2) Turn left, sign posted Garmelow. The land and pool on your right are owned and managed by the Parish Council. Carry on along the lane, passing Dairy House Farm and barn conversions on your left.

(3) After a few yards take the left fork and walk past the entrance to Horsley Hall to reach

Horsley Farm on your left in a corner. Turn left through a field gate and past the farm house on your left hand side. Keep the hedge on your right and pass through three fields to a stile giving access to a metalled road called Cash Lane.

(4) Turn left along the lane and past a cottage on your left to a pair of imposing stone gate posts. (5) This is a newly re-opened restricted byway. Cross through the fields and down to a gate next to Laundry Cottage. Turn right and follow Wincote Lane down to the main road, the A519 to Newport.

(6) At the junction turn left and follow the pavement to join a footpath on your left through a kissing gate. Head across the field to your left towards Johnson Hall, an attractive black and white residence. Go through two metal kissing gates and keep the pool on your right. Follow the finger posts uphill to a metal gate. When you meet the entrance to Johnson Hall veer slightly left and walk to a white gate.

(7) Follow the lane to the right and join Shaws Lane by the school. Turn left and after 75 metres join the footpath on your right through a wooden kissing gate. Walk back down the path to your starting point at the Washpits.
