Croxton Community Report:

1. Roads

a.) Successful response from Highways: New speed restriction sign installed at the crossroad; faulty street light now synchronised and off during daylight

b.) Awaiting response from Highways re:

- 40mph restriction signs at approach to Loggerheads to ensure safety of residents where there is no footpath facilitated.
- 'Unsuitable for HGV' signs to be installed at both ends of Fair Oak bank where problems have occurred with HGV on very narrow hill due to SAT NaV use.
- Sumping-out of blocked drain at the crossroads.

2. Recent Events:

Broughton Community Choir celebrated its 10th birthday. The 60+ choir has grown from strength to strength and members attend from all over Eccleshall Parish. The musical director (Martin Jones) has been nominated for a Community Award in the Inspiring Individual category.

3. Forthcoming date for diaries:

2019 Croxton Community Well Dressing - Saturday 6th July.

The theme for the main Well Dressing will be 'Celebrating N.W. Staffordshire, - 'The Pirehill Hundred'. (Eccleshall Parish fell within this Hundred for over 1,000 years). The planning group hope to liaise with Eccleshall Guides rather than a local primary school, to enable them to create a triptych Well Dressing at the Cattery well next July.
